DATA PROTECTION

Information provided on the competition entry form will be stored on a secure computer for the purposes of the administration of the competition, distribution of results & notification of future BDSRA events. Entry forms may be retained for a period of up to five years after the competition. Results will be retained indefinitely for the purposes of future reference & maintaining historical records, and as such may be distributed to interested parties.

It is a condition of entry that competitors agree to their surname & initials, club & scores appearing in the results of the meeting, these results may be published on appropriate shooting related websites. The BDSRA will not use any competitor's data for commercial purposes nor give permission for such use to a third party.

TIME ALLOWANCE

Each detail will be of 30 minutes duration 20 minutes for firing a 20-shot course plus unlimited sighting shots, and 10 minutes for target changing.

SQUADDING TIMES AND NUMBERS

Squad 3	12.30 pm	to	2.00 pm
Squad 4	2.00 pm	to	3.30 pm

Each competitor whose entry is accepted, and entry fee paid will be allocated to the squad requested or to the 2nd or 3rd choice stated on the entry form, if available. Should all the preferred squads be filled, the competitor will be offered whatever accommodation is available on the range. If this is not acceptable the entry fee will be returned upon receipt of a stamped addressed envelope.

RECORDED SCORES

It is the responsibility of competitors to ensure their scores are correctly recorded on the exhibited lists. A score may be challenged upon payment of £5.00 which will be returned if the challenge is upheld. No correspondence will be entered into after the meeting.

CLASSIFICATIONS

The meeting will be conducted in four classes A, B, C, and D.

Competitors will be allocated to classes in accordance with the averages submitted:

CLASS	A – 97.5 and over
	B – 95.5 and under 97.5
	C – 94.0 and under 95.5
	D – under 94.0

Individual averages will be calculated as stated on the entry form and must be certified by a club official.

The committee reserves the right to reclassify competitors.

If no average is stated class A will be assumed.

TARGET SYSTEM

The three-card system will be used and will be fully squadded.

RULES

N.S.R.A. rules and regulations will apply except for ties. These will be decided on the last card working backward. The bottom pair of diagrams being considered as the last card.

The range committee will settle disputes.

CONDUCT OF SHOOTING

- The course of fire will be an English Match (60 shots at 50 metres) using the 3 cards system. The match will be shot over 3 details each of 20 minutes, for unlimited sighters and 20 shots to count. A 10-minute period will be allowed between details for change of targets.
- Shot targets are to be handed to the Range Conducting Officer (RCO) at the end of each detail.
- No coaching will be allowed. Unless specifically agreed prior to the event starting with the meeting organisers.
- The competition will be separated into 4 classes A through D. Concurrent competitions will include open juniors, open ladies, open veterans and BDSRA Affiliated Clubs handicapped pairs. The handicap used will be as shown below. The system used will be to provide an equal opportunity across all classes. i.e. equate the average for all shooters.
 - o Class A - Scratch.
 - o Class B - +1 per hundred therefore +6 for the match.

- o Class C - +2 per hundred therefore +12 for the match.
- o Class D - +3 per hundred therefore +18 for the match.
- The Class averages will be as follows:
 - o Class A – Greater than 97.0
 - o Class B – 95.5 to 96.9
 - o Class C – 94.0 to 95.4
 - o Class D – less than 94.0
- Promotions / Demotions.
 - o Winners of each class, with the exception of A will be automatically promoted to the next higher class for the following year's competition.
 - o The competition organisers reserve the right to promote / demote shooters during the competition if clear evidence that the declared average is misleading.
- Awards.
 - o Although this competition is open to all the award of BDSRA trophies and shields is restricted to shooters who are members of BDSRA Affiliated Clubs.
 - o The removal of trophies will be restricted to BDSRA Affiliated Club members only, who will sign for receipt at the awards ceremony on the day of the shoot.
 - o Prizes will be awarded to the winners within each class of each competition.
 - o The following trophies and shields will be awarded to the highest placed BDSRA Affiliated Club shooter:
 - o Class A highest placed shooter will receive – the Class A Shield
 - o Class B highest placed shooter will receive – the Class B Shield
 - o Class C highest placed shooter will receive – the Class C Shield
 - o Class D highest placed shooter will receive – the Class D Shield
 - o Highest placed junior will receive – A small trophy to keep
 - o Highest placed lady will receive – A prize
 - o Highest placed veteran will receive – A prize
 - o Handicapped Pairs winners will receive – The HTV handicapped Pairs Trophy
 - o The George Waring (Cannons) Trophy.
 - o The George Waring (Cannons) Trophy and a medal to be awarded to the member of a BDSRA Affiliated Club who attains the highest score in any Class.
